



## CHAMPAGNE

**1. Bollinger Special Cuvée NV** 47.50  
A rich, full flavoured champagne with good bottle age – a little special!

**2. De Castelnau Brut NV** 30.00  
An explosion of ‘tiny bubbles’ with aromas and flavours of lychee, pineapple and a hint of honey – super quality.

### Rosé

**3. Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé** 55.00  
The quintessential Rosé, top quality, soft, elegant and full flavoured, sheer luxury.

## THE WHITE WINES

**4. Oyster Catcher Chardonnay 2009/10** 3.50 4.60 13.50  
The aroma of tropical fruit with a hint of fresh melon and the flavour of summer fruits make this a soft, round lovely wine from Chile.

**5. Mezzora Pinot Grigio Garganega 2009** 3.60 4.80 14.00  
Produced from grapes grown in the beautiful hills north of Verona, flavours of pears and summer peaches, gives a dry, fresh and stylish wine.

**6. Viognier de Pennautier 2009 - Vin de Pays d’Oc** 3.60 4.80 14.00  
An eruption of fresh peach, passion fruit and apricots abound in this smooth delicious wine which is made from grapes grown on the cool slopes of the Montagne Noir.

**7. Añuela Sauvignon Blanc 2010 ‘Casablanca Valley’** 3.60 4.80 15.00  
Just a few miles from the Pacific Ocean the Casablanca Valley produces some of the very best Chilean Sauvignon. The intense aromas of fresh herb and apple, together with the flavour of exotic fruits and ripe pineapple make this smooth, lively and distinctive zesty wine.

**8. Willunga100 Pinot Gris 2009** 18.00  
Grapes from selected vineyards in the cooler Adelaide hills produce this truly pleasant wine, the aromas and flavour of pear and citrus abound in this soft, elegant well-structured Pinot Gris.

**9. Runnymede Island Sauvignon 2009/10 ‘Marlborough’** 18.00  
Bursting with green fruit flavours and a herbaceous twist this delicious thirst quenching Sauvignon is what New Zealand does best.

**10. Chablis ‘Le Classique’ 2009 Pascal Bouchard** 22.00  
This highly distinctive full flavoured classic Burgundy is from a family producer situated in the world famous village of Chablis. Only grapes from selected vineyards go to make this vibrant full flavoured wine which has the trademark minerality found in the best wines from this region.

**11. Gavi di Gavi ‘Vigneti Lugarara’ 2009** 23.00  
This top estate covers 30 hectares in the heart of Piemonte. The wines are of the best quality -the Cortese grapes are gently pressed; they see no oak thus creating a wine that has a great concentration of flavours and balanced acidity, and this is certainly one of the best that Italy produces.

## ROSÉ

- 12. Steenbok Pinotage Rosé 2010** 3.60 4.80 14.00  
From South Africa, liquid strawberries and ripe cherries abound in this delicious elegant rosé.
- 13. Domaine Houchart Rosé 2009 'Sainte Victoire'** 17.50  
Strawberry pink in colour this fresh elegant rosé has the flavour of ripe summer fruits with a hint of white peach. Soft and delicate from one of Provence's best properties.

## AND THE REDS

- 14. Oyster Catcher Cabernet Sauvignon 2009** 3.50 4.60 13.50  
A delicious elegant fruit-driven South American Cabernet. The aromas of ripe berry fruit with the flavour of plum and a hint of chocolate – easy everyday drinking.
- 15. Matumi Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon 2009** 3.60 4.80 14.00  
The family owned property producing this wine was established just outside Cape Town in 1700. Grapes are hand picked and the wine is aged in French oak which, with refined soft tannins, results in a wine with an abundance of blackcurrant fruit and just a hint of violet, it has a smooth lasting finish.
- 16. Chateau de Moulin de Mallet 2007 AC Bordeaux** 3.60 4.80 14.00  
Family owned since 1898 this property sits overlooking the Dordogne valley and the slopes of St Emilion. The perfume and flavour of ripe red and black fruits together with soft tannins from the high proportion of Merlot in the blend make this truly pleasurable easy to drink red Bordeaux.
- 17. Añuela Merlot 2009 'Colchagua Valley'** 3.60 4.80 14.00  
From vineyards situated between the Andes and the Pacific this handpicked Merlot has the aromas of plum and fresh mulberries. It is soft and elegant with the flavours of ripe berry fruits and just a hint of vanilla from its time in barrel.
- 18. Vondeling 'Baldrick' Shiraz 2008/09** 16.50  
Young Southwest facing vineyards planted in on of South Africa's best independent properties make this delicious blend of mainly Shiraz, a hint if Mourvedre and a little Viognier. Clean, pure red and black fruits abound with just a hint of oak and a little spices on its smooth juicy lingering finish.
- 19. Côtes du Ventoux 2009 'Jérôme Quiot'** 16.50  
Stunning red from the Southern Rhône, big full flavoured yet with a soft round elegant finish.
- 20. Rioja El Coto 'Crianza' 2006** 17.50  
A quality oak aged wine from Northern Spain's best Bodega; it is distinctive with the flavours of ripe red berries and a hint of vanilla coming from having spent some time in new oak casks.
- 21. Willow Bridge Cabernet Merlot 2008/09** 18.00  
Aromas of ripe black cherries, summer berries and a little oak make this elegant wine a true pleasure on any occasion.
- 22. Ara Pinot Noir 2008/09 'Marlborough'** 18.00  
Vineyards formed on an ancient river terrace make this well balanced New Zealand red. A mass of fruit with the aromas and flavours of strawberry and ripe cherry, with the texture and elegance only found in the best Marlborough wines.
- 23. Fleurie 2009 Domaine de la Bouronière** 20.00  
One of the most popular of the ten individual Beaujolais villages, this medium bodied wine has an intense raspberry fruit flavour and delivers excellent quality, try it slightly chilled.
- 24. Da Vinci Chianti Classico 2007** 23.00  
From steep vineyards situated between Florence and Siena this classic Chianti is made under the watchful eye of Alberto Antonini. Deep ruby in colour with the fragrance of fresh plum and spicy blackberries, full bodied with soft subtle tannins and ripe fruit flavours, finished with just a hint of cinnamon from the oak ageing, classic Sangiovese.
